The activities must be designed to primarily benefit low and moderate-income persons, aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight, or meet an urgent need of the community. The goal of this meeting is to obtain elected official input on projects that need attention in their area of the county.

Citizens and officials from villages and townships are invited and encouraged to attend this meeting on April 7, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. to provide their input on the needs for their individual area of the county. The meeting will be held in the County Commissioners' meeting room at 110 Cottage Street, Ashland.
